Whereas Army S. Ewbank, on or about the 14th day
 of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred, exhibited her
 complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid
 against Herbert B. Ewbank, Ernest L. Ewbank, Arthur L. Ewbank
 and Anne B. DeHon demanding judgment in relation to the
 real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, and the cause being
 at issue, came on to be heard on the first day of December 1900
 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree
 of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the
 said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed
 to D. P. Verner, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the
 terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by
 reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; and the said
 decree having provided that the plaintiff do pay the Master for
 Greenville County on or before the 15th day of December instant, the
 sum of Twenty-four hundred Dollars being for the interest of
 all the defendants in the tract of land set forth in paragraph
 6 of the complaint, and she having paid the sum of money mentioned
 in said decree, and in all respects complied with the con-
 ditions prescribed therein, and the said decree having further
 provided that upon said payment being made to the Master
 as aforesaid, by the plaintiff that then the said Master
