 Whereas, R. W. Allen, S. R. Preston, B. E. Graham, A. F. Means, J. Fairman Preston and O. P. Mills a majority of the Board of Directors of Chicora College, a corporation created under and pursuant to the laws of South Carolina, by certificate issued under the hand of the Secretary of State, and the Great Seal of South Carolina, on the 25th day of April, A. D. 1898, have certified over their signatures, Resolutions authorizing in behalf of the aforesaid Corporation an increase of the Capital Stock (authorized and set forth in the certificate aforesaid) to the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, which Resolutions were adopted pursuant to law, at a meeting of the stockholders of the aforesaid corporation, of which thirty days published notice was given, which notice stated the purpose of the aforesaid meeting, and further that said resolutions were adopted by a two-third vote and that in all respect there had been complied with the provisions of "An Act to Provide for the Increase and Decrease of the Capital Stock of Corporations in this State, Except Railroad, Railway, Tramway, Turnpike and Canal Corporations," approved March 1st, A. D. 1899.
 Now Therefore, I, M. R. Cooper, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, entitled "An Act

to Provide for the Increase and Decrease of the Capital Stock of Corporations in this State, Except Railroad, Railway, Tramway, Turnpike and Canal Corporations," approved March 1st, A. 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Whereas, By an Act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, entitled "An Act in Relation to Forfeited Lands, Delinquent Lands and Collection of Taxes" and Acts Amundatory thereof, it is provided that immediately upon the expiration of the time allowed by law for the payment of taxes in any year, the County Treasurer of each County shall issue, in the name of the State, a warrant or execution against each defaulting taxpayer in his County, directed to the Sheriff or his lawful Deputy, requiring and commanding him to levy the same by distress and sale of so much of the taxpayer's estate, real or personal, or both, as may be sufficient to satisfy the taxes - State, School, County and Special - of such defaulting and further that under and by virtue of such warrant or ex-
