Donaldson, my Attorney in fact, in consideration of Five hundred and fifty (\$550.00) dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R.L. Quinn of the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R.L. Quinn, All those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, in what is known as Park Place, near the City of Greenville, a revised plat of which is of record in the Register Meane Conveyance office for Greenville County in the State of South Carolina in Plat Book A. at page 119, said lots numbers 8 in Block J and 1 and 9 in Block N. on said revised plat and a part of the tract of land which was sold and conveyed to J.W. Cagle, T.Q. Donaldson and William Wilkins by Alexander Stewart and Jacob Susong by deed bearing date 21st, March, 1890 and recorded in book VV, at page 651 in R.M.C. office in and for Greenville County in the State of South Carolina and a part of the same tract which includes the lot herein conveyed, sold and conveyed to me by J.W. Cagle, T.Q. Donaldson and Harriet D. Wilkins, by deed bearing date the 6th, day of July, 1908 and recorded in book or Vol. ZZZ, page 40, R.M.C. office for Greenville County in the State of South Carolina.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said R.L. Quinn, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said R.L. Quinn, and his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof.
