Davenport, he being the highest bidder, NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J.M. Holliday, Emma Mahaffey, Jane Woodson, H.C. Holliday and R.L. Holliday, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One thousand one hundred and fifty-six dollars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by D.P. Davenport, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell And release unto the said D.P. Davenport and his heirs and assigns forever, all our interest, which is one-fifth of the whole each, in a certain tract of land containing 53-1/2 acres, be the same more or less, it being tract No. 3 of the land belonging to the Estate of Our Mother Nancy Holliday, dead, described as follows: Beginning on a Pine-stump 3X, with R.D. Dawkins & Cason tract; thence S. 33-3/4 E. 29 chains to a Pine-stump 3X; thence S. 14-3/4 W. 14.80 chains to a stake 3X; thence N. 79-1/4 W. 15 chains to a Pine-stump 3X; thence S. 47 W. 8.60 chains to a stake 3X; thence N. 5.38 chains to a Pine 3X; thence N. 23 E. 11.37 chains to a china 3X; thence N. 3 E. 14 chains to a oak 3X; thence N. 2-1/2 W. 5 chains to a bl.-gum 3X; thence N. 22 E. 6.84 chains to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Mrs. J.T. Cothran, Mrs Lonnie Coker, Mrs. Ed Gossett, Ed Gossett and Lot No. 2 of the Nancy Holliday Estate, situated in Dunklin Township, Greenville County So. Carolina.
