Indenture made the 22nd., day of November, 1910, between G.H. Mahon of Greenville, Party of the first part, and Wilton H. Earle of Greenville, party of the second part.

WHEREAS the said party of the first part, on the 22nd, day of November, 1910, recovered by judgement rendered in the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Greenville against John T. Chapman and M.J. Chapman in the sum of Four hundred and sixty-eight and 12/100 dollars (\$468.12); now this indenture witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the amount he owes said party of the second part for legal services, and a further consideration of Five dollars to him duly paid, by these presents doth, assign, transfer, and set over unto the said party of the second part, and his assigns, the said judgement and all sum and sums of money that may be had or obtained by means thereof, or on any proceedings to be had thereupon.

And the said party of the first part doth hereby constitute and appoint the said party of the second part or his assignee, his true and lawful attorney irrevocable, with power of substitution and revocation, for the use and at the proper costs and charges of the said party of the second part, to ask, demand and receive, and to sue out executions, and to take all lawful ways for the recovery of the money due or to become due on the said judgement; and on payment to acknowledge satisfaction, or discharge the same.

And the said party of the first part does covenant that there is now due on the said judgement the sum of Four Hundred and sixty-eight and 12/100 dollars, with interest from this date at seven per cent.
