This agreement made this 8th day of February, 1901 between Mrs. Mary J. Foster and Frank C. Owens, both of Greenville, S.C. Witnesseth; that whereas the house belonging to Frank C. Owens on Laurens Street next to that of the said Mrs Fosters is so near her land line that the water drops off on to her fence and land, and whereas it is mutually agreed by these presents that the said Mrs Foster hereby consents for herself her heirs and assigns to the said State of affairs above described and the said Frank C. Owens, in lieu thereof binds himself, his heirs and assigns to either keep the fence, which is now between these houses, in as good condition as it now is, replacing the same as it is damaged or worn from time to time or else he will put a gutter on the side of his house to convey the water away from the said fence whichever he deems best.
