Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, One dollar in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have any interest in, it the-----, of County of Greenville Co., and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads, Streets or highways adjoining the said property with the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said line so as to keep the wires cleared at least eighteen inches, to erect and set the necessary guy and braces poles and anchors and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor and with the right to cut all underbrush interfering with said line.
