Lucinda V. Neves, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lucinda V. Neves all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being

in the State and County aforesaid on Meadow Fork, waters of Mash Creek, Beginning at a stake on M.L. McKinney's line; thence N. 73 E. 8.50 ch. to a stone 3 x; thence S. 26 E. 2.05 ch. to a stone; thence N. 85 E. 10.45 ch. to a stone; thence S. 16 E. 6.32 ch. to a stone; thence S. 24 1/2 E. 4.95 ch. to a stone; thence N. 65 E. 12.00 ch. to a stake in Meadow Fork; thence S. 19 1/2 E. 30.46 ch. down said creek to a stake; thence S. 37 W. 15.35 ch to a stake on B.F. Neves line; thence N. 43 W. 41.30 to a stone; thence N. 53 W. 11.00 ch. to a stake in Tugalo road; thence N. 12 E 7.00 ch. to the beginning corner, containing One hundred and five acres, more or less.
