(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Thompson, all that piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and in Paris Mountain Township, on Reedy River, and containing nine (9) acres, more or less and has the following marks, bearings and distances, to wit; Beginning on a stone 3 X nm, on Reedy River; thence S. 44 E. 21 to a stone 3 X nm; thence S. 77-1/2 E. 5.62 to a stone 3 X nm (on Winn's line); thence N. 27-1/2 E. 6.30 to a stone 3 X nm; thence N. 69 E. 10.90 to a Maple 3 X nm (on old river bed); thence to the beginning corner this tract is known as tract No. 8, of the Estate of Thomas Thompson, deceased, as shown by plat made by Jno M. Cureton, D.S. on November, 14, 1905 and adjoining lands of Henry Winn and tract Nos, 7, 9, and 10, as shown by the above named plat.
