demanding judgment in relation to the real-estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of September 1909, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real-estate hereinafter mentioned and described: be conveyed by J. W. GRAY, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; and the said Quintus A. having paid the sums of money mentioned in said decree, and in all respects complied with the conditions prescribed therein to wit:

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, J. W. GRAY, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the performance of the conditions aforesaid, and the payment of thirty and 88/100 Dollars, by the said Quintus A. Green

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Quintus A. Green, all that certain parcel or tract of land situate in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, containing sixty-seven and eighty-one hundredths (67-80) acres, more or less, and known as tract No. 1 in plat of survey of the lands of the Estate of Edward S. Green, deceased, made by W.A. Adams, surveyor, October 1909 and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake in center of S. RR. track, corner of School House lot; thence N. 10 E. 23.50 along settlement Road to bend in road; thence N. 5 E. 16.75 along said road to bend in road; thence N. - 1/2 E. 3.85 along said road to a point therein; thence N. 53-1/2 W. 6.00 to stake; thence N. 13-1/2 W. 4.00 across Mountain Creek to stone; corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of Lot No. 4 S. 36 W. 36.50 to stone, corner of lots 2,3, & 4; thence S. 40-1/2 E. 23.50 to corner of School House Lot; thence N. 56 E. 1.75 to stake; thence S. 40-1/2 E. 7.00 to the beginning corner, all of which more fully appear on the above described plat.
