the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mollie Shockley, an undivided one-seventh interest in of or to all that certain

parcel or tract of land situate in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid containing sixty-two and three-fourth acres (62-3/4) more or less, and known as Tract No. 3 in plat of survey of the lands of the Estate of Edward S. Green, deceased, made by W.A. Adams, S. October 1909 and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone in old Rutherford Road and running; thence across New Rutherford Road S. 72-1/2 E. 19.06 to stone, corner of tract No. 2; thence N. 30 E. 31.88 to stone, corner of tracts Nos. 1, 2, and 4; thence N. 78-1/8 W. 25.09 to stake in Rutherford Road; thence along the center of said road S. 13 W. 10.14 to bend in road; thence along said road S. 21 W. 14.00 across South fork of Mountain Creek to point where new Rutherford Road enters into old Rutherford Road; thence along old Rutherford road S. 29-1/2 W. 4.50 to the beginning corner, all of which more fully appears on the above described plat.

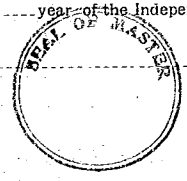
