to wit: the costs of the above stated action, sixteen and 65/100 dollars

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, J. W. GRAY, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the performance of the conditions aforesaid, and the payment of Sixteen and 65/100 Dollars, by the said Susan Sims

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Susan Sims, all that certain piece and parcel of land situate, lying and being in the county of Greenville, and State aforesaid, about two and a half or three miles from Greenville Court house, Beginning on a pine 3X and running; thence N. 4 W. 2.68 chains to a rock 3X on road; thence N. 85 E. 1.62 chains to a rock 3X on same road; thence S. 81-1/2 E. 5.27 chains rock 3X; on road thence S. 71 W. 7.61 chains to the beginning corner, containing nine-tenth (9/10) of one acre, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Susan Sims, her heirs and assigns forever.
