the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release, unto the said H. J. Haynsworth, all the right, title and interest of William Plumley, deceased

in, of or to that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in County and State aforesaid, Containing two hundred acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to wit; Beginning on a Poplar; thence N. 39 W. 9.50 to a Hickory; thence N. 60 W. 12 to a Pine, thence N. 23 E. 6 to a forked maple; thence N. 33 W. to a stake; thence N. 37 W. 10 to a stake thence N. 33 W. 10 to a stake; thence S. 57 E. 10 to a Locust; thence S. 45 W. 50 to a Chestnut thence S. 77 W. 20 to a Chestnut; thence S. 45 W. 13.50 to a Hickory; thence S. 52 E. 25 to a stake; thence S. 80 E. 17 to a stake; thence N. 63 E. 35 to the beginning Poplar, being the tract of land conveyed by Grant to Richard Brazile bearing date Sept. 7, 1793 and known as tract No. 4, in the sale of the lands of William Plumley, Deceased sold by the Master in and for Greenville County on Salesday in January 1907.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said H. J. Haynsworth

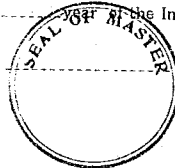
