KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, J. R. Tripp, J. R. Watson, H. W. Murff and R. F. Wyatt, the duly elected trustees ("Parsonage Trustees") for the Methodist Protestant Church; a corporation under the laws of South Carolina, at Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. E. Hill (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said W. E. Hill, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the first Ward of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds to wit; Beginning at a stake on the west side of of Loyd Street on corner of T. M. Pickens' lot, and running thence westwardly with his line one Hundred and thirty-five and a quarter (135 $\frac{1}{4}$) feet to a stake on line of lot recently sold by us to A. L. Henderson; thence with Henderson's line in a southerly direction thirty (30) feet to a stake; thence in an easterly direction with A. L. Henderson's line thirty (30) feet to a stake; thence in a southerly direction along A. L. Henderson's line Twenty-eight (28) feet to a stake. thence in an easterly direction in a straight line parallel with John Street one Hundred and five and a quarter (105 $\frac{1}{4}$) feet to a stake on the west side of Loyd Street; thence in a northerly direction along said Loyd Street Fifty-eight (58) feet to the beginning corner; this being a portion of a lot of land conveyed by the late John Burdine to R. M. Pickens, Henry M. Murff and Samuel Wyatt, Trustees for the Methodist Protestant Church, by a deed bearing date May 19, 1879, and recorded on the day of its date in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said State and County in Book "JJ" of Deeds at page 504; the said property hereby conveyed having been set apart for a parsonage by said church, and the said J. R. Tripp, J. R. Watson, H. W. Murff and R. F. Wyatt having been duly elected by said church as parsonage trustees, as successors to the trustees named by the said John Burdine in his said deed to the Methodist Protestant Church;
