Lawrence of the County and State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Sarah A. Lawrence all that lot and parcel of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid and Greenville Township, about one and one-half miles from Greenville Court House on the Rutherford Road, and having the following metes, bounds, courses and distances to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Rutherford Road at W.C. Earnhardt's corner and running; thence S. 66-3/4 E. 270 ft. to a stone; thence N. 27-3/4 E. ninety (90) ft. to a stone; thence N. 66-3/4 W. two hundred and seventy ft. (270) to an iron pin on Rutherford Road; thence S. 27-3/4 W. Ninety (90) ft. to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Miles G. Batson, Jr. by deed bearing date the 15th, day of May, 1890 and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in book ---- page 745.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Sarah A. Lawrence, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. Sarah A. Lawrence, her

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
