land, in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about Four and one-half (4-1/2) miles from Greenville court house, on the West side of the White Horse Road this one-half (1/2) interest being the same interest conveyed to me by Stella Burgess, by deed dated November 30th, 1907, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book W.W.W. page 126, reference to which is hereby craved. Said one-half (1/2) interest conveyed by me having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone XOM and running; thence N. 65 E. 19.55 to a stone XOM; thence N. 59-1/2 E. 2.08 to a stone OM; thence N. 5-1/2 W. 6.50 to a stone OM; thence N. 74-1/2 E. 5.11 to a stone OM; thence N. 31 W. 6.33 to a stone XOM; thence S. 74-1/2 W. 11.33 to a black-gum-stump OM; thence S. 25-1/4 W. 21.85 to the beginning corner, and containing twenty-three and three-fourths acres (23-3/4) more or less, as shown by plat of W.A.
