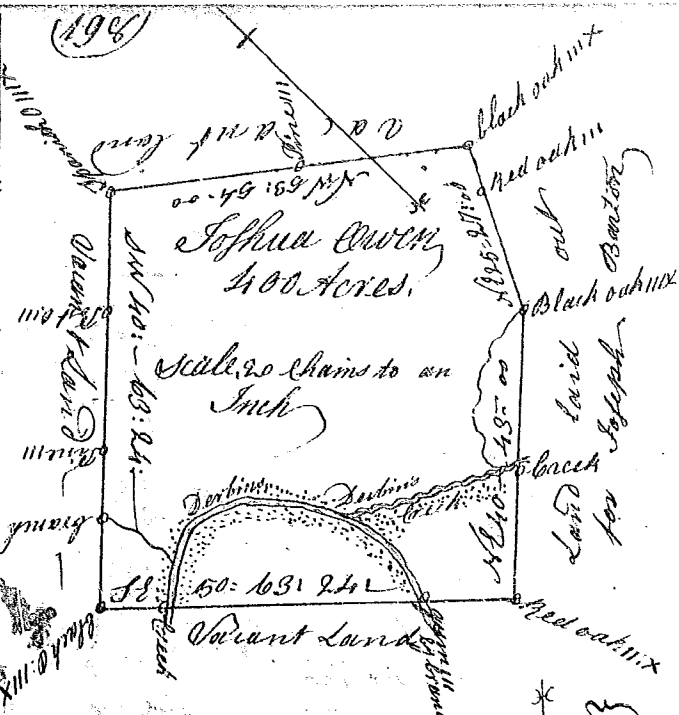


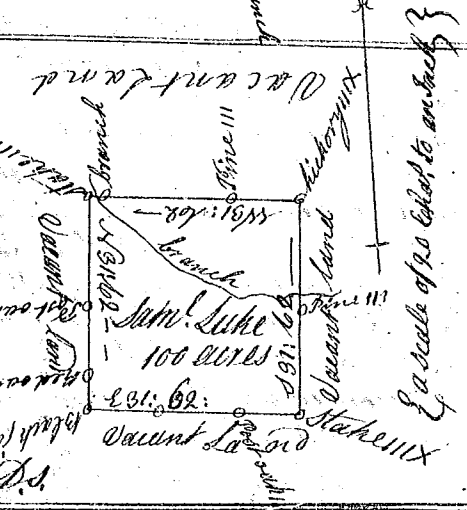
State of South Carolina,

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of locations in Ninety six District No. 80 of Saluda River, dated the 12<sup>th</sup> July 1784, I have admeasured and laid out unto Samuel Luke a tract of land containing one hundred acres, on a small branch of Dimeons Creek below the Indian boundary bounding on all sides on vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as the annexed Plat Represents, Surveyed 10<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1784, Recorded 9 Nov. 1784, Rob<sup>t</sup> Hanna D.S.



State of S. Carolina

Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of locations in Ninety six District No. 80 of Saluda River Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> of Sept. 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto Samuel Brown a tract containing 640 acres of land. Situated in Ninety six District. Below the ancient Boundary line, on Saluda River bounded N<sup>W</sup> on James May son of John Phillips land E<sup>o</sup> on Benajah Thomsons land all other sides by the River. And hath such shape and marks as the annexed plat Represents, Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1784
