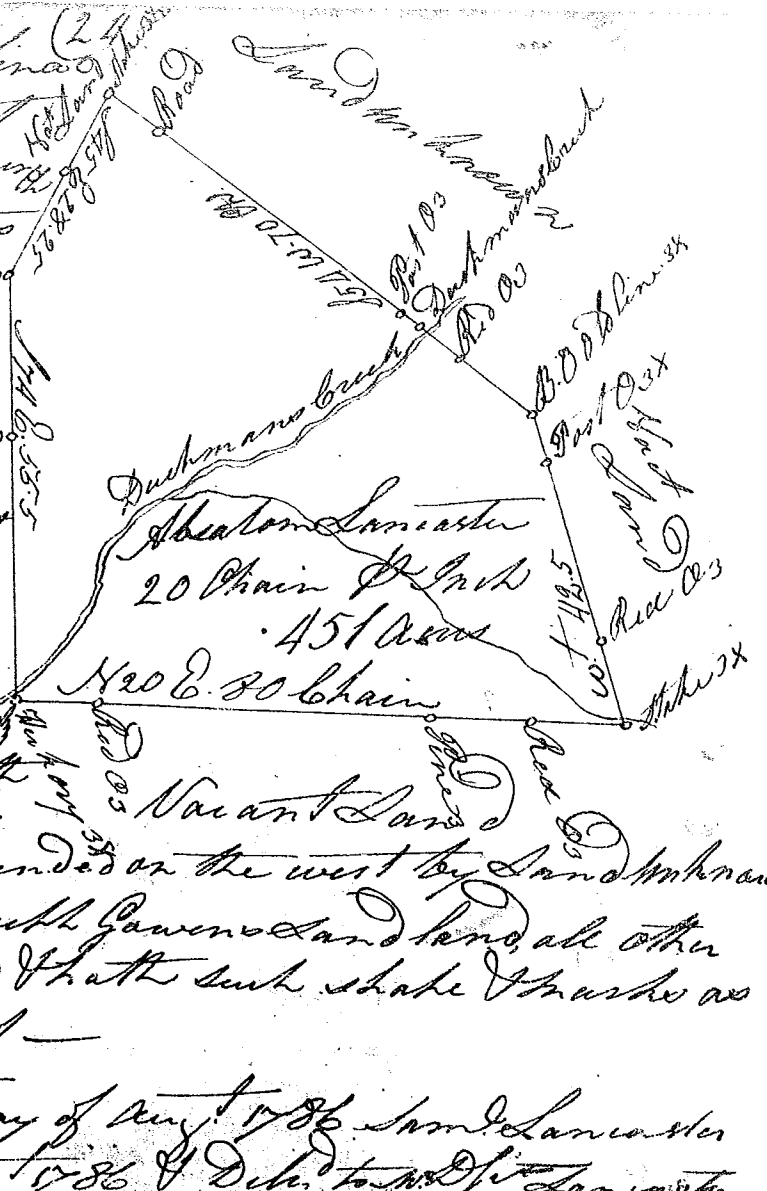


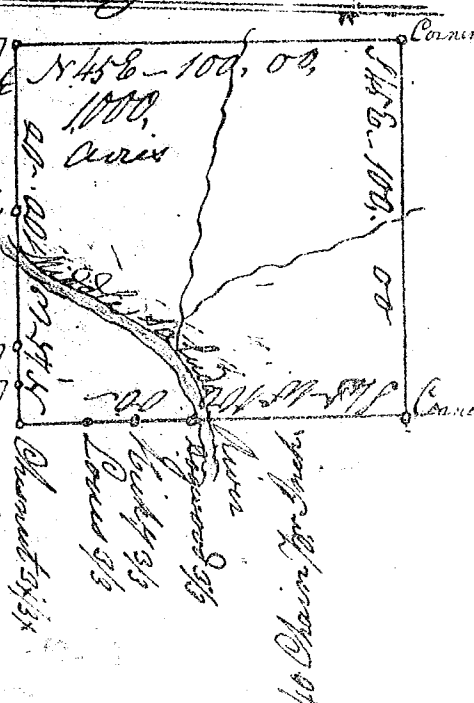

 of One thousand Acres of Land, situate in

 to the SE by the NW on the aforesaid NW and  
 John Youngs Land, to the NE by  
 Vacant Land, and hath such shape form  
 and marks as the above Plat represents
