Cooke Esqr Commissioner of Locations for Greenville District dated the 1st day of September 1814, I have admeasured and laid out to Isaac Henderson a Tract of land, containing Two hundred Acres Situated in Greenville District Aforesaid on both Sides of the Sinkhole Branch and other ^{single} branches of the North fork of Saluda River, Bounded on all Sides by Vaillant mountains and hath such shapes and marks as the above plat Represents
