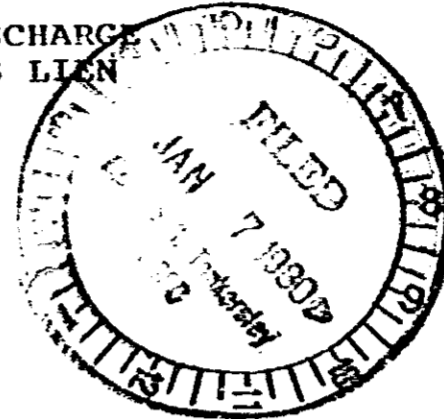

BOND TO DISCHARGE  
 MECHANIC'S LIEN



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Quality Mechanical Contractors, Inc., as principal, and United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company, as surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County in the sum of Eleven Thousand Fifty-two and 95/100 (\$11,052.95) Dollars, lawful money of the United States, together with any costs, interest and attorney's fees, if any, which may be found due Lienor by this Court, for which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of December, 1979, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book 18, at page 198, a Notice and Statement of Mechanic's Lien or a claim in the sum of Eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-nine and 92/100 (\$8,289.92) Dollars, was filed against certain property owned by Sears, Roebuck & Co., said property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

WHEREAS, Sears, Roebuck & Co. is the owner of the above-mentioned property, which is the subject of the Mechanic's Lien, and has heretofore caused certain additions to be constructed on said property; and Quality Mechanical Contractors, Inc. was and is a sub-contractor for the above-described construction, and Quality Mechanical Contractors, Inc. desires to have the said
