That Cecil's Inc., General Contractors, contracted with Ashmore Bros., Inc. for the job; that said materials, supplies and labor were furnished with the knowledge and consent of Villgreen, a Limited Partnership.

That ninety (90) days have not elapsed since the supplying of the last supplies, materials and labor and such were last delivered on June 20, 1980.

That the reasonable price of such materials, supplies and labor after all credits was in the sum of Thirteen Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy and 19/100 (\$13,970.19) Dollars, as per Statement of Account, attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

That Plaintiff is entitled to reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Plaintiff in this action; that the said sum of Thirteen Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy and 19/100 (\$13,970.19) Dollars, together with the reasonable attorney fees, is now due and owing to the Plaintiff for which sum the Plaintiff now claims a Mechanic's Lien upon the said premises and the improvements thereon.
