January 5, 1981, deponent sent Mr. Roach to Greenville to see if he could locate Mr. Pope; and he reported to me by long distance that he had been unable to locate him. In the meantime I had had a telephone conversation with Arthur Ledford of Spartanburg, South Carolina, who said that he had loaned Randy L. Pope the sum of Sixteen Thousand (\$16,000.00) Dollars which was to be repaid within a few days before Christmas, 1980; and that the same was not repaid; and that he had attempted to located Mr. Pope but was unable to do so. Mr. Ledford further told deponent that a Mr. John Awad had given Randy L. Pope the sum of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.00) Dollars to purchase diamonds from an individual; that the diamonds never were delivered; and that when Mr. Awad attempted to locate Mr. Pope, he could not. Deponent further states that he telephoned Mary Pope, wife of Randy L. Pope, on the 8th day of January, 1981, and that she told him Mr. Pope was not in; that she didn't know when he would return; and that she did not know where he was.
