The following is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge: My name is Stanley K. Sinclair and I am President of Landmark Construction Company, Inc. of Spartanburg. In July, 1982 a notice and certificate of Mechanic's Lien was filed by Rainbow Painters, Inc. against South Carolina National Bank and Stanley K. Sinclair, d/b/a Landmark Construction Company, for work and materials allegedly furnished at the following premises:

> All of South Carolina National Bank's rights and interest in and to the building located on Woodruff Road near the intersection with I-85 in Greenville, South Carolina, which contains a new mini-bank.

This notice and certificate of Mechanic's Lien alleged that the last labor or materials furnished on this building was on May 14, 1982.

In August, 1982, a cash bond was posted by Landmark Construction Company, Inc. of Spartanburg in order to release the lien against the property of South Carolina National Bank. This bond was a cashier's check in the amount of Two Thousand, Seventy-Two and 58/100 (\$2,072.58) Dollars made payable to Landmark Construction Company, Inc. This money was posted with the Register of Mesne Conveyance in Greenville County.

No law suit has been served upon me or any agent of Landmark Construction Company, Inc. to foreclose this Mechanic's Lien.
