

The purpose of Plaintiff's amendment is to correct a mistake and insert other allegations and material to the case as provided for in Section 15-13-920 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976. After amendment the Complaint will allege substantially all the same facts except that it will only seek judgment for the amount owed to the Plaintiff under the oral contract already alleged in the Complaint. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that Plaintiff's action for foreclosure of Mechanic's Lien be dismissed, that Plaintiff's Mechanic's Lien be dissolved, and, that Plaintiff's Motion to Amend be granted.
