

indebtedness allegedly due to the IRS in the amount of \$19,000.00, plus interest and penalties, will be withdrawn from this proceeding since resolution of this matter with the IRS has not yet been accomplished, but without prejudice to the plaintiff's right to seek indemnification from the defendant for his share of any amount ultimately paid or owing to the IRS. Once the matter with the IRS has been resolved, plaintiff shall be at liberty to seek reimbursement from the defendant, and this settlement shall in no way affect plaintiff's rights or defendant's rights in that regard.

IT IS, ACCORDINGLY, ORDERED that plaintiff may enter judgment forthwith against the defendant in the amount of \$4,917.33 and that portion of the present Complaint dealing with legal expenses shall be, and is hereby deemed, concluded and res judicata.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint as to the remaining claim of the plaintiff, ²⁴ i.e. the possible indebtedness to the IRS, shall be dismissed without prejudice. The Warrant of Attachment is hereby dissolved, as is the Lis Pendens, filed in connection therewith, and the Clerk of this Court is, accordingly, ordered to take such action as may be necessary to accomplish the dissolution of said Warrant and Lis Pendens.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
