

Parcel #1

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as part of the land conveyed to me by deed from E. Inman, Master, adjoining lands of myself Ed Eppes and others beginning on an iron I.P. near a maple thence N. 38 1/2 W. 1.00 to a spring 5.27 chs. to an I.P. thence N. 45 E. 6.67 to I.P. N.M. thence S. 83 E. 5.00 to an I. P. thence N. 88 E. 1.00 to I. P. n.m. thence S. 1 W. 3.20 to I. P. n.m. thence S. 26 E. 4.96 chs. to I.P. on road thence S. 22 W. 36 links to a W. O. on road thence N. 81 W. 7.35 to I. P. thence S. 47 1/2 W. 2 near a maple the beginning corner and contains (7) seven acres more or less my wife and myself to have a life time interest in the above described land.

Parcel #2

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land lying situate and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, joining the properties of E. L. Cox estate, Henry Cox and Buford Bridges, and being known as a part of the land conveyed to the grantors by deed of E. L. Cox, dated November 17, 1937, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds No. 201, page 59. Being more fully described with the following metes and bound according to a plat and survey made by Terry T. Dill, Reg.C.E. & L.S. No. 104, dated August 14, 1967.

Beginning on an iron pin on the east side of the County road and running thence S. 88-15 W. 141.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-15 W. 286.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-15 E. 160.1 feet to nail and cap in county road (iron pin offset west side of County road); thence S. 5-15 E. 189.9 feet to the beginning corner, more or less.
