YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to the provisions of Section 368, Subsection d, of Act No. 368 of the Acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina for 1953, and any amendments thereto, the South Carolina Mental Health Commission claims and has a lien from the date of March 1, 1942, upon all of the real and personal property of William David Taylor for the expense incurred by the State of South Carolina in furnishing medical care and maintenance in a State mental health facility to the said William David Taylor, the amount of said expense to the State as of the date hereof being \$812.67. This lien will also attach to any real or personal property as may be hereafter acquired by the said William David Taylor while the above-stated amount is unpaid.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the South Carolina Mental Health Commission will claim under this lien such further amounts as accrue after the date above set out, for any further medical care and maintenance received in any State mental health facility by the above-named licensee, at the regular rates charged therefor.
