Highway 14) and containing 8.75 acres, more or less, having the following courses: BEGINNING at an iron pin at corner of the thirteen acre tract, and which from pin is in said highway, and running thence with said highway, S. 22-30 E. 293 feet to an iron pin near Culvert pipe; thence leaving said highway, S. 64-30W. 429 feet to a stake; thence S. 69-22 E. 153.7 feet to a stone; thence N. 73-30 W. 564 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-00 E. 281 feet to said thirteen acre tract; thence N. 84-44 E. 887.5 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the north by the thirteen acre tract; on the east by said highway; on the south by lands now or formerly owned by Herman L. Gibbs; on the west by lands now or formerly of Sam Nix.
