KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Virginia T. Whitmire, 204 McElhane, Road, Travelers Rest, S.C. 29690 of South Carolina,

as principal, and the Firemen's Insurance Company of Newark, New Jersey a corporation under the laws of the State of New Jersey

duly authorized to transact business in the State of South Carolina (hereinafter called the company), as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto South Carolina Tax Commission for and on behalf of the State of South Carolina in the penal sum of Seventy Five Thousand and no/100 (\$75,000.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, the above bonded Virginia T. Whitmire has been appointed by the South Carolina Tax Commission to sell tax stamps on consignment as authorized by Section 65-653, Volume 6, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Virginia T. Whitmire shall faithfully and honestly account for all tax stamps consigned to him by the South Carolina Tax Commission and promptly pay over and account to the said South Carolina Tax Commission for all monies coming into his hands from the sale of tax stamps, in manner or form now or hereafter required and in full compliance with the rules and regulations now or hereafter promulgated by the South Carolina Tax Commission, then this obligation to be VOID, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

- THE LIABILITY OF THE SURETY HEREUNDER SHALL TERMINATE: (a.) Upon notice by the South Carolina Tax Commission to the Surety of any default hereunder. (b.) Thirty (30) days after receipt by the South Carolina Tax Commission of written notice from the Surety of its desire to terminate liability. (c.) Upon receipt of written notice by the Surety from the South Carolina Tax Commission terminating the same.
