in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of TWO THOUSAND & NO/100

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of (\$20.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid;
