SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Norman Thompson

, to be paid one year after date or,
Thirty Dollars (\$ 30.00) paid on the first day of each Month until the
sum of Twenty One Hundred and Fifty (\$ 2150.00) Dollars with interest
has been paid

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of Five per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
