

shall first be obtained in writing, but if any of the restrictions hereinabove set forth shall be broken or violated by the grantees, their successors or assigns, then the abovementioned premises shall immediately and automatically revert to the grantor, its successors and assigns; and

WHEREAS, the membership and congregation of Union Bleachery Baptist Church at a conference held on October 31, 1948, authorized and directed the Board of Deacons of said church to borrow from The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee for the John W. Arrington Foundation, the sum of Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000.00) Dollars and to give as security therefor a mortgage on the within described property on which the church building is located; and

WHEREAS, The Aspinook Corporation, The Lawrence Print Works, Inc., and Arnold Print Works, Inc., each of which is a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, are the successors in title of Union Bleachery, a South Carolina corporation, the said Union Bleachery having conveyed all its property, including reversionary interests, to the three above named corporations on July 31, 1947, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 318, at Page 58;

E. Robertson, W. H. Wigington, R. W. Robinson, Jesse D. Brown, and A. D. Boswell, as the Board of Deacons of Union Bleachery Baptist Church to The South Carolina National Bank, as Trustee of the John W. Arrington Foundation, to be dated November 11, 1948, securing a note of even date in the sum of Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000.00)
