porated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Fourteen Hundred, Twenty-Five and
no/100 Dollars (\$ 1,425.00), with interest from date at the rate of
four per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable
at the office of The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina
in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Eight and 64/100
Dollars (\$ 8.64), commencing on the first day of
February, 19 49, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and
interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and
payable on the first day of January, 19 69.

payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor
in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described
property situated in the county of Greenville, Gantt Township,
State of South Carolina; known and designated as Lot No. 83, according to plat
of property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest
side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds,

the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty
and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
