All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being the rear 32 feet of Lot No. 201 of the McCrary property according to plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "A", Page 279, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
