TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Greenville Home Builders, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Citizens Lumber Company, a Corporation, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Six Thousand and No/100- - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 6,000.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: in monthly installments of \$60.00 each on the 7th day of each month hereafter, beginning March 7, 1949; said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6%, per annum, to be computed semi-annually and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Northern side of Grove Road, in the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 71, and a portion of Lot No. 75 as shown on Plat of Langley Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, Engs., in June 1937, recorded in Plat Book N at Page 133, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of Grove Road, 233 feet West from Hawthorne Lane, at corner of Lot No. 72, and running thence with the line of said lot and continuing N. 18-12 W. 233.2 feet to a stake on an alley; thence with the Southern side of said alley, S. 68-06 W. 38 feet, more or less, to a stake at corner of Lot No. 70; thence with the line of said lot, S. 13-48 E. 225.8 feet to a stake on Grove Road; thence with the Northern side of Grove Road, N. 76-12 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by John H. Coker et al by deed dated January 20, 1949, recorded in Book of Deeds 371 at Page 360.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
