TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, W. M. Barnett; (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Forty-one Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS (\$ 4,100.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, formerly School District 8-GD, on the Southern side of Stewart Street, being shown and delineated as Lot No. 13, Book C, on revised plat of property of F. A. Lawton known as "Kanatamah", made by J. E. Serrine & Co., Engineers, August 25, 1923, recorded in Plat Book "F" at Page 131, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at the corner of Lot No. 14, 360 feet West from Mitchell Street, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 26-30 E. 165 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of said lot, S. 63-35 W. 60 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 12; thence with the line of said lot, N. 26-30 W. 165 feet to a stake on Stewart Street; thence with the Southern side of Stewart Street, N. 63-35 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner."

The above described premises are the same conveyed to J. F. Barnett by F. A. Lawton by deed recorded in Volume 91 at Page 263. The mortgagor, together with Joe F. Barnett, Jr., and Edith Barnett Hinn, are the sole heirs-at-law of J. F. Barnett, as will appear by reference to Apartment 533, File 19, in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, and the interest of Joe F. Barnett, Jr. and Edith B. Hinn was conveyed to the mortgagor by deed to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
