TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **Gaynell B. Greenwood**, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **TWENTY FIVE HUNDRED & No/100 DOLLARS (\$ 2500.00)**, with interest thereon from date at the rate of **five per centum per annum**, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northwestern side of Briarcliffe Drive (formerly Central Avenue) in the City of Greenville being shown as part of lot 19 and part of lot 20 on plat of Dixie Heights recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at page 46, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northwestern side of Briarcliffe Drive (formerly Central Avenue) said point being in the front line of lot 19 and 30 feet from the joint corner of 18 and 19, and running thence along Briarcliffe Drive N.43-12 E. 60 feet to an iron pin in front line of lot No. 20, which pin is 10 feet from the corner of lot No. 21; thence through lot No. 20 N.46-48 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S.43-12 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of the property now or formerly owned by J.A. Carson; thence through lot No. 19 S.46-48 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning. Said lot being composed of 20 feet from lot 19 and 40 feet from lot No. 20, and being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Vol. 347 at page 90.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
