bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal  
proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Sallie Barksdale

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and  
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Tillmon Young and Geneva Young.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, near  
Calhoun Street, and being known and designated as Lot "H" on plat recorded  
in Plat Book #C" at page 13; said lot having a frontage of 35.9 feet on a  
ten foot alley, and a depth in parallel lines approximately 100 feet, said  
lot adjoins lot "G" and "I".

This being the same lot conveyed to Sallie Barksdale by deed
