on the North side of Charles Street, being known and designated as Lots
Nos. 46 and 47 of a subdivision known as "Newland" as shown on plat

at page 199 and being in Block 1 and having the following metes and
bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of
Charles Street and Newland Avenue and running thence along the line of
