all that tract or lot of land in

Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. containing four acres, according to survey by J. Mac Richardson, registered surveyor, dated June, 1947, and having, according to said survey, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Boiling Springs Road on line of property conveyed by Francis Ward Burns to Hudson and running thence along the Hudson line, N. 79-06 E. 6.75 chains, more or less, to iron pin; thence along the line of property of Hood, N. 0-40 E. 5.34 chains to iron pin; thence along the line of property of Ross, S. 78-25 W. 8.20 chains, more or less, to iron pin in center of Boiling Springs Road; thence along the center of said road, S. 14-39 E. 5.20 chains, more or less, to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
