ed, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

all that tract or lot of land in  
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
lying and being situate on the Southern side of Prancer Avenue, within the limits of  
the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot # 307,  
Pleasant Valley, according to plat of said sub-division prepared by Dalton & Neves  
in April, 1946, including additions to said plat through November, 1948, as recorded  
in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and  
having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Prancer Avenue at joint  
front corner of Lots # 306 and # 307, said pin being 360 feet Northeast  
of iron pin in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Prancer Avenue
