Whereas, Greenville, S. C., the said St. Michael's Evangelical Lutheran Church of hereinafter called the mortgagor(s) in and by its certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, is well and truly indebted to The Board of American Missions of the United Lutheran Church of America, a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Fifty-five Hundred and No/100 - - -

E. Dalton, Engineer, in March 1923, and having according to said plat, when described together, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
