called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incor-  
porated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Seventy-Five Hundred and No/100- - - -

Dollars (\$ 7500.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of  
Four- - - - - per centum ( 4 % ) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable  
at the office of Canal Insurance Company  
in Greenville, S.C.

, or at such other place as the holder of the note may  
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-Five and 45/100  
Dollars (\$ 45.45 ), commencing on the first day of  
October , 19 50 , and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and  
interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and  
payable on the first day of September , 19 70.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the  
payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor  
in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does  
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described  
property situated in the county of Greenville,  
State of South Carolina; on the Northwestern corner of Potomac Avenue and Panama Avenue,  
and being shown as lot No. 184, on plat of Pleasant Valley recorded in Plat Book P  
at Page 88, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwestern corner of Potomac Avenue and  
Panama Avenue, and running thence with the Western side of Panama Avenue, N. 2-57 E.  
160.2 feet to a stake; thence S. 89-52 W. 78 feet to a stake at corner of lot No.  
185; thence with the line of said lot, S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to a stake on Potomac  
Avenue; thence with the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, N. 89-52 E. 70 feet to  
the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by H. P. Asay, Jr., et al  
by deed to be recorded.
