Whereas, WE, the said W. E. & MARY Y. SHEALY

Presents, ARE well and truly indebted to EUGENE BURNS

in the full and just sum of EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY NINE DOLLARS AND FORTY FOUR CENTS (\$859.44), to be paid IN FULL

, with interest thereon from DATE

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid \$15.00 per month, or more,

beginning January 1, 1951 until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal: and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage: and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said EUGENE BURNS

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located just off Paris Mountain Road on what is known as Edgewood Avenue in a subdivision known as Leawood, property of C. M. Gaffney, Trustee, according to plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June, 1938 and recorded in Plat Book "J" pages 18 and 19 in the R.M.C Office, Greenville County, being known and designated as Lot # 41 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Edgewood Avenue, joint corners of lots 40 and 41; thence N. 55-18 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint corners of lots 42 and 41; thence N. 33-54 E. 164.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55-41 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 33-54 W. 164.7 feet to the point of beginning.
