(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Bank of Travelers Rest

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Five Hundred Ninety-Seven and 11/100

maturity DOLLARS (\$ 597.11),
with interest thereon from ~~date~~ at the rate of Six per centum per annum, said principal ~~and interest to be~~ repaid: \$50.00 on April 15, 1951, and a like payment of \$50.00 on the 15th day of each month thereafter until one year after date, at which time the unpaid balance will be due and payable, with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, on the West side of Tubbs Mountain Road and bounded on the south by Bonyan Bowen, on the West by H. McCall, and on the North by other lands of Paul Hunt, containing 3.08 acres and described as follows:
