

BEGINNING at a stake on the northerly side of Galloway Street located N. 84—07 W., 430.2 ft. from a concrete monument on the northerly side of Galloway Street at the southwestern corner of property now or formerly of Lum Belton, and running from said point of beginning as so established along the northerly side of Galloway Street, N. 84—07 W., 56.8 ft. to a concrete monument; thence along the northerly side of Galloway Street, N. 83—20 W. 133.5 ft. to an iron pipe at the southeasterly corner of property now or formerly of H. H. Webb and others; thence along the property now or formerly of H. H.
