To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Etta Coleman Caplan, formerly Etta Louise Coleman..... SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Etta Coleman Caplan, formerly Etta Louise Coleman.....

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred and No/100 (\$2,600.00...)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of.....

Twenty-Six and No/100 (\$.26.00.....) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said Etta Coleman Caplan, formerly Etta Louise Coleman.....

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the subdivision known as City View, on the north side of Ninth Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 17, Block A, as shown on plat recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 427. This lot is on Ninth Street, in City View, and fronts 50 feet on Ninth Street, runs back 155 feet and is 50 feet wide in the rear. Being the same property devised to me under the will of my husband, C. L. Coleman, who died December 6, 1948. Said will is on file in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apt. 562, page 6.
