TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, **Hashell J. Murrell and Betty Jo Murrell**
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **W. L. King**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Seven Hundred and No/100 - - -**

DOLLARS (\$700.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **\$50.00** on 19 day of August, 1951, and a like payment of **\$50.00** on the 19 day of each month thereafter until paid in full, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the **Southwestern side of Evergreen Street (formerly Douglas Avenue) near the City of Greenville, being the rear 60 feet of lots 70 and 71, as shown on a plat of property of Colonia Co. made by Dalton & Neves in Sept. 1925, recorded in Plat Book G at Page 112, and described as follows:**

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwestern side of Evergreen Street, 290 feet Northwest from Franklin Road, and running thence with the Southwestern side of said Street, N. 44-02 W. 60 feet to a stake at corner of lot 72; thence with the line of said lot, S. 46-03 W. 120 feet to a stake at corner of lot 69; thence with the line of said lot, S. 44-02 E. 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 46-03 E. 120 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by John P. Taylor by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 409 at Page 113.

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is junior in lien to a mortgage executed by the mortgagors to Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association in the original sum of \$5000.00 recorded in Book of Mortgages 496 at Page 208.
