SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said **N. W. McCall**

in and by **my** certain **promisory** note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, **am** well and truly indebted to **The Pelzer-Williamston Bank**

in the full and just sum of **Eleven hundred thirty-two and 98/100----(\$1,132.98)**
---Dollars, to be paid in monthly instalments of **\$64.00** each
month beginning **September 25, 1951**

, with interest thereon from **maturity**
at the rate of **6** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually**

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, its successors and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of U. S. Highway No.
29, and known and designated as Lots numbers 5,6,7 and 8 of the T. D.
Bennett Subdivision, as shown by plat made by Sam Lowe, Registered
C. E. August 24, 1948, and recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C.
Office in Plat Book S at page 143, and according to said plat more
particularly described as follows;

BEGINNING at a stake on the western side of U. S. Highway No. 29
at the joint ^{front} corners of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the
western side of said Highway N. 4-05 W. 100 feet to a corner,
joint corners of lots 8 and 9; thence S. 85-45 W. 201.7 feet to
the eastern line of Lot No. 26; thence with the eastern line of
Lot No. 26 S. 4-20 E. 100 feet to a corner; joint rear corner
of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence N. 85-45 E. 200.9 feet to the
beginning corner.

These lots are the same four lots conveyed to me by Jim Hamby by
his deed dated August 19, 1950, duly recorded in R.M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Vol. at page .
