MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, G. W. Lollis and Agnes Mabel Lollis of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said G. W. Lollis and Agnes Mabel Lollis

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of Two Thousand, Two Hundred and No/100 - - - (\$ 2,200.00 )

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

Twenty-Two and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 22.00 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said G. W. Lollis and Agnes Mabel Lollis.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, ac-

ording to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us,

the said G. W. Lollis and Agnes Mabel Lollis

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township on the Eastern side of South Haven Drive, being all of Lot No. 59 and the northern portion of Lot No. 60 of a subdivision known as Buncombe Park according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 12, and having, according to a plat of the property of Agnes Mabel and Gray Walter Lollis prepared by C. C. Jones, Engineer, November, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of South Haven Drive at the original joint front corner of Lots Nos. 60 and 61 of Buncombe Park, and running thence on a new line through Lot No. 60, S. 87-34 E. 480 feet, more or less, to Langston Creek (iron pin off set on bank); thence along the line of Langston Creek, N. 10-15 W. 21 feet to an iron pin off set on bank, the original joint rear corner of Lots 59 and 60; thence continuing along the line of Langston Creek, N. 11-30 W. 133 feet to an iron pin off set on bank; thence along the common line of Lots 58 and 59, of Buncombe Park, S. 85 W. 408 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of South Haven Drive, the joint front corner of said lots; thence along the eastern side of South Haven Drive, S. 23-00 W. 120 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to us by Henry H. Jones by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
